The Denver Area Council BSA requires Tour Permits outlining destinations, drivers, and vehicle information for any Boy Scout/Troop activity which involves traveling to a location outside of the Parker area. All drivers who will be transporting scouts to a Troop activity must be at least 21 years of age and must follow Youth Protection Guidelines.
